



Exposure: Meeting one another in a safe environment

Hearing one anothr's stories

share thoughts openly in a safe space - and really listen to each other

use creativity to show differences see "the other" in oneself - see similarities put someone at ease

Media/narration: depict "the Other" in a very individual, specific way always avoid violence to acknowledge we are having stereotypes and to be thankful when we are being corrected

to feel responsible in contributing to correct prejudices in your group

Assuming full equality

Kindness

Sharing surprising stories/ unexpected plot twists

Setting ground rules for meetings (like no personal attacks; privacy)

taking the time to get knowledge/share experiences

ask your self: which stereotypes are associated to that group, both negative and positive? Being careful to both! stereotype can separate but they can also bring together (tackle?) By promoting an alternative, pluralist,inclusive discourse (CSOs can play a positive role)

Take a strong stance against (harmful) stereotypes.


open up or provide space for SLOW round tables Awareness raising projects with media professionals

Look at the textbooks in school curriculum and remove all negative stereotypes

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
